The language and the level required: Good English knowledge
Deadlines for applications: Winter semester - 1st June Summer semester - 15th November

Minimum amount of Erasmus scholarship for this exchange: 300 Euros
Student support: The students union is usually very welcoming for international students and ex-Erasmus students will serve as tutors if necessary.
Grading system: 0 to 20

Costs: In Porto you may need a budget of about 400 Euros. For example, a ticket for the metro is about 0.80 Euros, and a bus 1.25Euros. A meal will cost about 5 or 6 Euros per person, but having lunch in the institute's canteen will only cost you about 2 to 3 Euros. Accommodation in a shared apartment (meaning you take one room and share the rest of the house) may cost about 100 Euros, generally with the rest of the house expenses covered, such as water, electricity, etc.
Why Instituto Politecnico do Porto - ISCAP: An institute with more than a century of history, running in new facilities with a growing level of educational quality that you can take advantage of.
