<b>Short Presentation:</b> Over the past 100 years, Kolding Business School has developed from a small local evening school to a major educational institution. The school now has than 6000 students, of which 3,400 are full-time. The IBA is a long-standing member of the Network of International Business Schools and also has strong partnerships with many companies and organisations worldwide. Currently, there are approximately 350 students on IBA programmes. Students come from Denmark and abroad and they form the basis for an interesting, attractive and international study environment. Locally, regionally, nationally and globally, the IBA is today synonymous with high-quality international business education.
<b>Facilities and Conditions:</b> BA students have access to a large computer room with internet access 24 hours a day. A large student common room is available for relaxation, group work and “Friday-bar” on Friday afternoons. Apart from this, there is a library at the school. IBA also has a Student Council, a politically independent body representing students in negotiations with course management, lecturers and other employees at the school. The Student Council is responsible for planning of activities such as PR/marketing, “Friday-bar” and various social arrangements/parties.

<b>Necessary papers:</b> Application Form, Your CV/resume in English, Accommodation form (if you would like the IBA to find accommodation for you), Buddy Form (if you want buddy assistance on arrival).

<b>The language and the level required:</b> Good English knowledge
<b>Deadlines for applications:</b> Autumn Semester: 15 June Spring Semester: 1st December

<b>Minimum amount of Erasmus scholarship for this exchange:</b> 300 Euros
<b>Student support:</b> The IBA will assist you with finding accommodation. The school will apply for an apartment on your behalf. The “apartment application system“ is a database run by Kolding City administration for students in Kolding. You will receive one offer through the school once we have received the offer through the database. We expect that you accept this offer. If you say no you must find accommodation yourself. However, in general students do not turn down an offer unless they cannot afford the rent for that apartment. Kolding City does not have dorms (where you share bath/kitchen) so if you want to live with other students you must inform them and they will try to find a bigger apartment where 2-3 students can live together.

<b>Internships:</b> Students must make their own research their companies

<b>Costs:</b> It is of course difficult to predict what you will need while you are in Kolding but if you live a normal and not too expensive life it might look like this:  <b>Monthly</b> Rent: varies from 2,000 - 3,000 DKK Electricity: appr. 300 DKK Insurance: appr. 200 DKK TV licence: 100 DKK Mobil phone: 150 DKK (internet: 250 DKK) Food: 500-1,000 DKK
