**Costs:** Currency rate: 7,45 DKK = 1 €

Accommodation costs may vary from 1995-3500 DKK per month, depending on the type of accommodation.

Students should consider about 500 DKK per month for transport.

Compared to other European countries, food and personal care items are expensive in Denmark. To get an idea of the price level, you can visit the websites of supermarket chains in Denmark, such as Fotex, Netto, Aldi, Lidl, etc.

Apart from accommodation you will need approximately 3000DK monthly.

The sum may be smaller, depending on your individual needs.
